Tillamook County 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment Sanctuary Ordinance Limiting Firearm Regulation

Question

Should Tillamook County officials be prevented from enforcing most state, federal, and local firearm regulations?

Statement

This ordinance would prevent Tillamook County and its employees from devoting resources or participating in any way in the enforcement of any law or regulation that affected an individual's right to keep and bear arms, firearm accessories, or ammunition.

Although this ordinance would generally prohibit county officials from following firearms regulations, exceptions would be allowed in certain limited situations. County officials could still comply with firearms laws that relate to convicted felons, could still participate in the enforcement of firearm crimes, and could still take any actions necessary to comply with court orders.

Violators of this ordinance would be subject to civil penalties such as fines up to \$2000 dollars for individuals and \$4000 dollars for a corporation.
